The ancestors of Jesus

Jesus Christ came from the family of King David and also from the family of Abraham...

From Abraham to King David, his ancestors were:

Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Judah and his brothers...

Ram, Amminadab, Nahshon, Salmon, Boaz... Obed... Jesse, and King David.

From David to the time of the exile in Babylonia, the ancestors of Jesus were:

David, Solomon... Rehoboam, Abijah, Asa, Jehoshaphat, Jehoram;

Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, Hezekiah, Manasseh, Amon, Josiah, and Jehoiachin and his brothers.

From the exile to the birth of Jesus, his ancestors were:

Eliud, Eleazar, Matthan, Jacob, and Joseph, the husband of Mary, the mother of Jesus, who is called the Messiah.

There were fourteen generations from Abraham to David. There were also fourteen generations from David to the exile in Babylonia and fourteen more to the birth of the Messiah.

Fair Trade

Work in a group to plan a presentation on Fair Trade. You can plan to use more people outside your planning group if you need extra voices or pairs of hands to hold things.

Here are some ideas to get you started. You could:

- ☛ Show the audience some Fair Trade products and packaging. You could show some and shout out the names of more (there are now over 250 so you won't need to include all of them).
- ☛ Show the Fairtrade logo and explain it. Make a large copy of it.
- ☛ Find out which anniversary Fair Trade in Britain is celebrating this year. Find some important milestones to explain how it has gathered energy as a campaign.
- ☛ Find an example of someone whose life has changed since Fair Trade came to Britain.
- ☛ List some facts about Fair Trade.
- ☛ Explain why Fair Trade is important and makes such a difference.
- ☛ Choose a particular product and explain how it is made or grown, then link it to Fair Trade—for example, bananas, coffee or chocolate.
- ☛ Explain how much of the cost of a bar of chocolate goes to the growers of the cocoa beans and how much to each of the other groups in the chain.
- ☛ Find anything that famous people have said about Fair Trade.
- ☛ Martin Luther King once said, 'Before you've finished your breakfast this morning, you'll have relied on half the world.' Explain what he meant.
- ☛ Use a website to research, but only write down or paste sentences that you and your audience will understand.
- ☛ Find out which shops in your area stock Fair Trade products (the Co-op was the first main supermarket to do so).

Finally, decide what you want to present, then sort out the jobs. Who will get which section ready? What equipment will you need?
