# PARENTAL CONSENT FORM

In the event of an emergency, we need your consent to administer First Aid to your child and, if necessary, take them to hospital for medical treatment. We have trained First Aiders among our helpers or can call on local First Aiders.

# SESSION PLAN FOR NOAH'S JOURNEY

Activities can be removed, added or altered according to the ability and circumstances of your group. Provide extension activities for children who finish early. For example, the children could use watercolours to produce pictures of Noah's experiences, or make bubble prints by blowing (and only blowing) down a straw into a mixture of watered-down paint and washing-up liquid to create coloured bubbles, then laying paper over them.

# SESSION PLAN FOR MOSES' JOURNEY

Activities can be removed, added or altered according to the ability and circumstances of your group. Provide extension activities for children who finish early. For example, encourage the children to make sandy pictures using card or stiff paper, coloured sand or gravel (available from aquatic suppliers) and glue, with string to mark boundaries between different colours; or ask them to draw what they think the promised land might look like.
